### ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Tarkasaṃgraha of Annambhaṭṭa is the fundamental as well as foundational text in Sanskrit on the ancient Indian system of logic and reasoning. It is an introductory manual to introduce Nyāya – vaiśeṣika system of Indian Philosophy. On one hand, it beautifully presents linguistic model of the universe and on the other, it introduces the age - old Indian logic and epistemology in a very lucid yet profound language. According to Annambhaṭṭa this text has been written for the easy comprehension of any firsthand learner of Indian Philosophy. As a very popular text it has sparked a large number of commentaries on it. Annambhaṭṭa himself has given a detailed glossary on it, named Tarkasaṃgraha Dpikā. As a text 'Tarkasaṃgraha' is taught compulsorily in graduation and post-graduation level in different colleges and universities across India. This workshop is another small yet dedicated attempt to explore the full text with the help of the different eminent scholars of Indian Philosophy across country. The organizers of this workshop whole heartedly cherish the hope that their honest endeavour will help the participants to understand the Nyāya – vaiśeṣika system of Indian Philosophy in a fresh light as the workshop prioritizes on the close reading(s) of the text.
